Maylee has amassed a large and fervent following and become a frequent guest on popular television

shows Good Morning Texas and Good Day Dallas while receiving strong support from several north Texas P-1 radio stations.

Maylee has released five albums on Love Life Records, an indie label. Her debut CD, Rhythm of the Blues, was recorded with sax legend Clarence Clemons of Bruce Springsteen's famed E Street Band. The album also featured an array of other industry legends including bassist Chuck Rainey, drummer Jamie Oldaker, B-3 guru Mike Finnigan, and guitarists Dave Grissom and Andy Timmons. 
